CLASSROOM COOKING CONTRACT

Discuss and come up with a class cooking agreement to be reviewed before every cooking project. You can come up with your own version using poster or chart paper, and either post it in your classroom, or take it out to read before starting. Every student should sign their name to agree.

EXAMPLE:

- We agree to be safe with all cooking utensils (knives, peeler, forks).
- We agree to be respectful of our friends likes and dislikes.
- We agree to try new things.
- We agree to work together.
- We agree to follow directions and problem solve.
- We agree to wait for an adult before starting cooking projects, using utensils, or turning on an oven or stove.
